

DYE SUBLIMATED FABRIC GRAPHICS CLEANING/WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Dye Sublimation Fabric Graphics can be cleaned and washed easily with good results. Successfully cleaning your graphics, depends on following instructions listed below. Results may vary depending on the contaminant, how dirty the graphics are, and what fabric you are cleaning.

SPOT CLEANING

- Fabric can be spot treated, as with typical laundry.
- Use mild soap and cold water .
- Test on a small spot in a less than obvious spot first.

MACHINE WASHING

- Fabric graphics can be machine washed in cold on a gentle cycle.
- Lay flat or hang to dry.

DO NOT IRON

- Use a hand or commercial steamer to eliminate any wrinkles or creases.

Some washing machines, including commercial / industrial, can be extremely punishing to your fabric graphics. The most gentle washing cycle option is strongly recommended.

We do not recommend washing Satin, Lucent Plus or Lucent fabrics. Results of washing these fabric graphics are inconsistent. Damage may occur.
